Prolonged summer droughts in recent years damaged plants from heat stress and lack of water. Some areas that are especially high/dry with rocky/compacted soils were affected greatly, while others with better access to moisture had a higher survival. Overall, it is estimated that there has been a 25% loss of trees since the original planting. PCD will continue to infill and replant areas to offset these losses.
