Aerial imagery from NAIP, captured June 2–3, 2025, shows maturing and slight expansion of canopy cover within the project area across all three sites (Attachment A).

Site visits were conducted by an ISA Certified Arborist on March 10, 2026 (Attachment B). The arborist confirmed there have been no significant windthrow or canopy gap events and no signs of encroachment on the properties.

- Site 1: Heard: 15 species of birds. Sighted: squirrels and early spring insects.
- Site 2: Heard and/or sighted: 23 species of birds heard. Sighted: deer, squirrels, and turtles.
- Site 3: Heard and/or sighted: 9 species of birds. Sighted: early spring insects. Signs: unidentified wildlife.

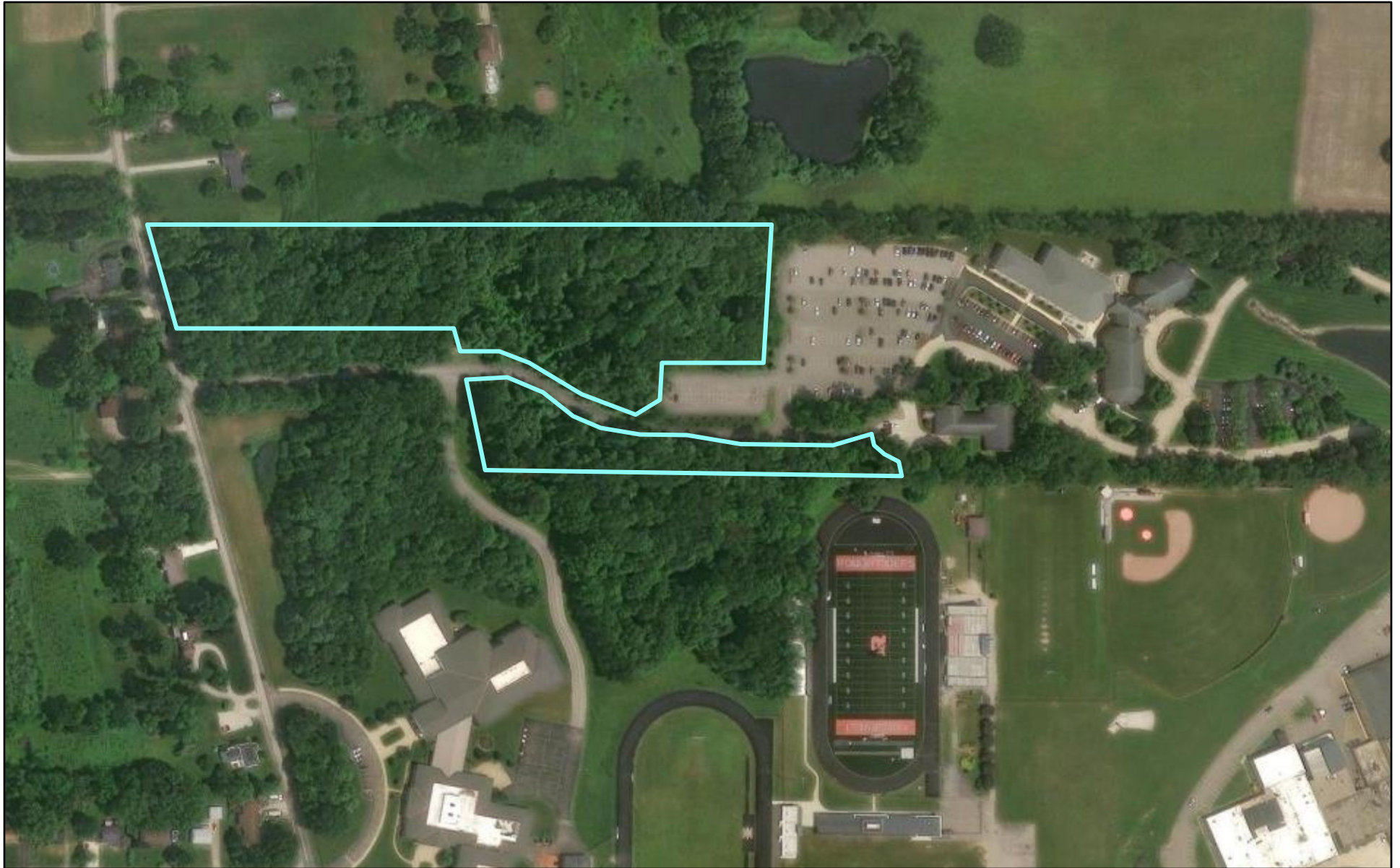

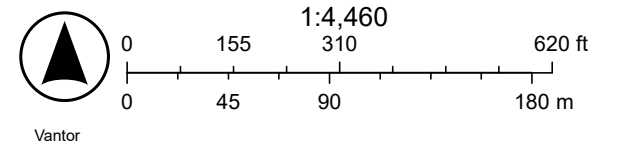

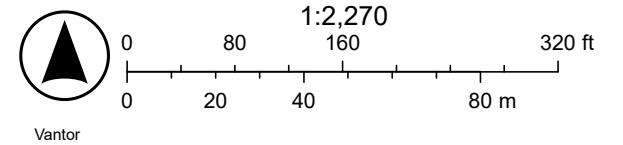
